Dear HAUC (England) Colleagues,

It has come to our attention that there have been a small number of issues and concerns around site location description within a USRN on a Permit application. As requested, we have reviewed and researched this issue and prepared the statement below to clarify the situation.

"Practitioners are reminded that Regulation 9 (4) of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 requires that each application for a permit shall be limited to one street, and further, as the Statutory Guidance mentions, should relate to a single USRN.

Where, once on site, it is apparent that the physical location of the works is different to that noted upon the permit, it is important that a "Street Manager" system transaction is sent to the Permit Authority for coordination and record keeping purposes, and to minimise any possible disruption upon the Road Network.

In these circumstances the Works Promotor and the Permit Authority should liaise and discuss the matter and any necessary remedial measures. Where there is a significant impact upon the running of the Road Network as a direct consequence of the result of the shortfall a Permit Authority may consider escalation."
